


# Port-Wide Facts & Figures

The Port of New York & New Jersey is the third largest port in the United States and the largest on the East Coast. In 2015, the Port handled:

- Over 3.6 million containers (nearly 6.4 million TEUs)
- More than 644,000 vehicles
- Over 37 million tons of bulk cargo
- Over 1.4 million cruise passengers
- More than \$204 billion worth of goods

## Regional Economic Impacts of the Port Industry

Port Industry operations provide:

- **190,100** direct jobs and **336,000** total jobs in the region
- Over **\$21.2 billion** in personal income
- Nearly **\$53.5 billion** in business income
- Approximately **\$7.1 billion** in federal, state, and local taxes
  - Over **\$2.3 billion** in state and local taxes
  - Over **\$4.7 billion** in federal taxes

This represents the ongoing economic value sustained in the 31-county NY metro region, which includes 12 counties in New York, 15 in New Jersey, and four in Pennsylvania.

Port Industry operations include vessel activities, marine terminal operations, warehousing and distribution, inland transportation and logistics providers, cruise operations, and supporting businesses such as banking, insurance, and freight-forwarding.

# Indirect Impacts on the Local Economy

Many companies in the region that are not primarily in the Port Industry import or export goods through the Port of NY & NJ. Collectively, these companies that rely on the Port for some aspect of their operations are critical to the local economy, generating an enormous number of jobs and tax revenues.

The following pages present estimates of the Port of NY & NJ's indirect and induced economic impacts on counties in the NY/NJ metropolitan area, using employer-level data about companies that import or export through the Port.

## Explanatory Notes

1. The employment and income figures presented on the following pages include **all** local employees of companies that import/export through the port. Note that many (if not most) of these employees' job functions are not directly related to trade and shipping. The assumption is that these companies operations rely, to some extent, on the ability to import and/or export goods.
2. Revenue reported includes non-local revenues, as headquarters locations report revenue for all branches/subsidiaries that fall under them.

- Over **2,400** of these companies are small businesses (<50 employees)
- Over **450** of these companies are minority or women-owned
- Examples of **major companies** in Bergen County that use the Port include Becton Dickinson, LG Electronics, Sharp, Unilever, and Sealed Air Corporation
